Dear Parents/Guardians,

Home-Based Learning in the Event of School Closure

As part of the preparations in relation to the COVID-19 outbreak, the school has prepared plans and resources to support your child's/ ward's learning in the event of a school closure.

There are two key plans in the school to support this continual learning:

- (i) Online Learning through Student Learning Space
- (ii) Printed Resources for Learning

(i) Online Learning through Student Learning Space (SLS)

Students will continue with their learning via SLS. To ensure that the learning experience is manageable by students on their own for self-directed learning, a maximum of two subjects will be assigned per day. For example, English Language and Science SLS packages will be assigned for the first day of the school closure, while Mathematics and Mother Tongue Language SLS packages will be assigned for the second day of the closure.

You may wish to enter your email address into your child's/ ward's SLS account to access the self-reset password feature at your convenience.

(ii) Printed Resources for Learning

In the unlikely event that SLS is unavailable, your child/ ward may proceed to use the printed resources prepared by the school for learning. Your child's/ ward's Form Teacher will be distributing the printed resources from 10 to 13 March to your child/ ward. **All students need to bring an A4 folder from 10 March** to keep these printed resources and store them neatly at home. Your child/ ward will only make use of the printed resources when advised by their Form Teacher.

Your child's/ ward's learning is important to all of us and we seek your support and understanding in this matter.
