## **2020 Essential Programme and School Charges for Primary 4 Students**

In line with our objective to provide a holistic education to our students, the school has planned a range of programmes, activities and learning resources to give your child/ward exposure and opportunities to discover and develop his/her talents. The school has consolidated the collection of payments for these programmes and learning resources required for the students of the level for Semester 1 2020. By doing so we hope to cut down the frequency of monetary collections from you.

Please refer to the attached Annex A for the essential programme and school charges with brief write-ups and the co-payment amount.

Please note that payment is not required at this moment. A School Bill stating the co-payment amount and the payment details will be issued to you in February 2020.

Payment for the essential programme fees and school charges is non-refundable. If payment is required for additional school programmes or school charges for Semester 1 or 2, we will advise you of the details and co-payment amount accordingly.

If your child/ward is a Singapore citizen and you have established an Edusave Enrichment Programme Standing Order, the co-payment amount for the Essential/Recommended Programme(s) will be deducted from his/her Edusave account, subject to the balance available. Should there be insufficient funds in your child/ward's Edusave account, the balance of the programme fees, after deducting the funds in your child's Edusave Account, will be reflected as cash payable amount in the School Bill. The School Bill can be settled via GIRO/NETS/ePayment or cash/cheque.
