The English Language department is adopting *What's Up*, a publication by News For Kids, as a supplementary resource material for use in our P5 and P6 curriculum.

Launched in 2003, *What's Up* is a monthly newspaper used in more than 50 primary and secondary schools in Singapore. It is focused on English language learning and features world news and current affairs written in a child-friendly way. Every issue of *What's Up* contains articles that can be used as resources for character and citizenship education. These include articles on government, the environment and other topics designed to awaken readers' minds to the idea that they are stakeholders in their society and the world. Through exposure to the interesting articles in *What's Up*, we hope to further develop our students' critical thinking and analytical skills as well as nurture in them the habit of reading newspapers from young.

As *What's Up* will be used during English Language lessons, subscription is compulsory. The cost of subscription to *What's Up* is **\$12.00 for 6 issues**. (Please refer to the subscription schedule printed overleaf)

You will be billed through the School Bill. If your child/ward is a Singaporean and you have established an Edusave Enrichment Programme Standing Order, the amount of **\$12.00** will be deducted from his/her Edusave account, subject to balance available. Should there be insufficient funds in your child/ward's Edusave account, the balance of the subscription fees, after deducting the funds in your child's Edusave Account, will be reflected as cash payable amount in the School Bill which can be settled via GIRO/NETS/ePayment or cash/cheque. Please also note that the cost of the subscription is non-refundable.
